The **Social Security Administration** has provided financial protection through retirement, disability, survivor and family benefits for over 80 years!



One financial disability benefit is **Supplemental Security Income (SSI)**; which is for adults and children if they have little or no income and resources, and have a disability, blindness or are 65 and older.



Youth with disabilities can apply for benefits the day after their

18th birthday.
